During 2016 FUNDAMOST has worked in a country in crisis, not only economically, but also morally, ethically and socially. We have emerged, despite the difficulties, as light in a country that cries for help.

Donations for Hospitals

Thanks to the support of Mustard Tree Missions, psychology and medical students, and other people of good will, we have managed to send donations of medical supplies, medicines,

toiletries, and other needed items to the Psychiatric Hospital of Maracaibo, the Nuestra Señora de Chiquinquirá Hospital in Maracaibo and the Public Ambulatory "Clinic on July 26" in the city of Cabimas. We have also donated baby formula, baby bottles and personal hygiene products to the unit of nutritional recovery located in the Chiquinquirá Hospital where there are currently 10 severely malnourished children and their mothers.



Within the facilities of the Chiquinquirá Hospital there is a room set up as a school for children who are hospitalized. We have been blessed to support this effort with donations of school materials so generously donated by friends in the U.S.


Christian medical students. It was our desire to not only bring them joy but to show these children, their parents

These 2 scholarships take about \$300 per person per year. We are currently doing it out of our salaries, but it is our wish to expand this project, looking for sponsors who wish to support our young students.



2016 was a year of many challenges for FUNDAMOST, and we are filled with great joy and gratitude to the Lord at having surpassed our own expectations. We want to thank all of you who donated so generously. We could not have accomplished all this without the supplies you sent and the financial gifts. We are extremely grateful.
